Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Welcome back everyone and I trust you had a rested break. Term 3 is underway and it's shaping up to be a busy one.

Parking/Bus Zone

At a school, 3pm pick up time is a busy time with lots of traffic, pedestrian and vehicles. **Please note - there is no parking on the curb on the left-hand side near the skip bin or in the bus zone at any time.** If your child is not out the front waiting can you please do the loop and come back around to allow the traffic to keep moving. **No parking is permitted at anytime in the 2 minute drop off zone.** Continue to be mindful about the 10km/hr speed limit in the carpark.

Police have been patrolling the school carpark and they will now be issuing tickets to people who are illegally parked either in the areas with yellow lines or in the bus zone. Our aim is to ensure we keep our parents and students safe. This means working together in a pleasant and friendly manner.

Student Swimming Costings for Term 4

Each year as part of our Physical Education curriculum, students undertake swimming lessons at Nambour Pool in Term 4. These fees need to be paid by **Wednesday 12 September 2018**.

You may wish to organise with Cathie, in the office, to undertake regular instalments via cash, cheque or direct deposit into the school account.

The costs are quite reasonable given the length of each lesson is 1 hour and the bus travel is included. The costs are based on full student participation, so no refunds will be given for non-attendance.

A Government 'Learn to swim' grant is provided to subsidise the cost of instructors for non-swimmers. Costs of lessons and bus travel are shown below.

Following on from our school carnival in which Kangaroos were successful, a 58 strong Mapleton team went to Conondale last Friday to compete in the Small Schools Carnival.

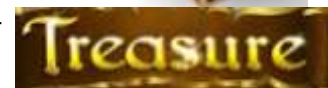
Our team performed well winning the track, field and overall trophies. Montville won the average overall trophy.
